
Cooperative Sports Team Agreement

THIS AGREEMENT, made by and between the Boards of Education of the Canton Area School District (Canton) and the Towanda Area School District (Towanda) for the purpose of expanding opportunities for participation in the Towanda Girls' Wrestling Team.

- 1. TERM: This Agreement shall be deemed effective the 1st day of July 2024 and shall continue for two (2) years thereafter. This Agreement shall automatically renew for an additional two-year term unless the respective Boards of Education take action within sixty (60) days of the renewal date to serve written notice to the other Board of Education of intent to terminate this Agreement.
- 2. HOST SCHOOL: Towarda is the Host School for the girls' varsity wrestling team. As Host School, Towarda shall be responsible to provide:
 - a. Scheduling of all contests and practices;
 - b. Hiring of coaches and officials; and
 - c. Uniforms for all players.
- 3. TRANSPORTATION: Towarda shall provide transportation for all away contests from Towarda's high school. Any Canton student participating in the wrestling program shall be responsible for their travel to and from practices, home contests, and to the Towarda bus for away contests. Canton shall allow early dismissal for participating students as necessary for timely arrival at all contests.
- 4. **ELIGIBILITY:** Eligibility shall be determined by the school the student attends.
- POINTS OF CONCERN: Complaints or concerns for this cooperative sport shall be addressed within the Host School's chain of command, unless action is necessary by the school the student attends.



Services to be rendered:

- IU 17 will provide a contracted SW to the District during the 2024-2025 school year, ending 5/30/2025. The SW will provide up to 2 days of service per week to the District, not to exceed 56 days, and is subject to all paid leave and benefits provisions provided to full-time IU 17 employees.
- The SW will provide direct services to students/families and will assist District's staff with implementing Social Work programming.

District Responsibilities:

- The District will make staff and resources available to support the SW. It is the district's
 responsibility to provide peripheral training within the District's allocated days in any
 areas needed to perform specialized roles in the District.
- The District will perform School-Based Access Program filing, if it wishes to secure Medical Access reimbursement for eligible Social Work service billing.
- Either party may terminate the agreement for any reason by providing a 30-day written notice to the other party.

Fees and costs:

The District will be billed the daily rate for the SW, which will be reconciled and invoiced with IU 17 Special Education contract billing. The daily rate, inclusive of benefit costs and administrative fees is \$650 per diem for the 2024-2025 school year, but the District agrees to pay actual costs for the position.

Services to be rendered:

- IU 17 will provide a contracted SMH to the District during the 2024-2025 school year, ending 5/30/2025. The SMH will provide up to 2 days of service per week to the District, not to exceed 40 days, and is subject to all paid leave and benefits provisions provided to full-time IU 17 employees.
- The SMH will provide direct services to students/families and will assist District's staff with implementing School-based Mental Health.

District Responsibilities:

- The District will make staff and resources available to support the SMH. It is the
 district's responsibility to provide peripheral training within the District's allocated days in
 any areas needed to perform specialized roles in the District.
- The District will perform School-Based Access Program filing, if it wishes to secure Medical Access reimbursement for eligible Social Work service billing.
- Either party may terminate the agreement for any reason by providing a 30-day written notice to the other party.

Fees and costs:

The District will be billed the daily rate for the SMH, which will be reconciled and invoiced with IU 17 Special Education contract billing. The daily rate, inclusive of benefit costs, round trip travel from Williamsport South academy to District, and administrative fees is \$350 per diem for the 2024-2025 school year, but the District agrees to pay actual costs for the position.

Community and School Based Behavioral Health (CSBBH)

Provider and School Agreement

The following are commitments required of Friendship House and **Canton Area School District** to ensure a successful implementation, fidelity and sustainability to the Community and School Based Behavioral Health (CSBBH) Program in the Canton Area Elementary School. A behavioral health treatment model developed by Community Care Behavioral Health Organization in partnership with educational, state, county, and family stakeholders.

Provider:

- Mobile Therapists (MTs) with be qualified Master Level clinicians, preferably with family systems training and experience.
- Behavioral Health Technicians (BHTs) will hold at minimum of a Bachelor degree with at least two years of
 experience in a clinical setting or appropriate training as required by IBHS regulations.
- The administrative director and clinical supervisor will ensure the clinical integrity of the model and adherence of the CSBBH program standards. They will provide on-site monitoring, clinical supervision and direct observation of services being delivered.
- FRIENDSHIP HOUSE will provide general agency support and access to organizational resources needed by the team to conduct daily CSBBH business.
- The CSBBH team will serve a flexibly sized cohort of youth and their families, in the school, home, and community settings, with staff availability during evenings and weekends, non-school holidays, and summers.
- The CSBBH team implement practices and engage in communication that supports families/caregivers as full
 and effective partners in the decision-making and treatment process.
- The CSBBH team will serve as a consultative resource to the school during crisis events for both CSBBH and non-CSBBH enrolled students and will help coordinate with formal crisis services as needed.
- The CSBBH team will provide 24/7 on-call services for Crisis events and case management services for the children enrolled in the CSBBH Program.
- FRIENDSHIP HOUSE and/or CSBBH team will provide in-service training to school staff regarding mental health needs or interventions as requested by the school.
- CSBBH is a voluntary service and require both medical necessity as well as active engagement by both student
 and family. Progress will be reviewed every 90 days and whether CSBBH continues to be the most appropriate
 service at that time will be determined.
- Authorizations are typically provided for 1 year of service, appropriateness for continuation of services will be determined both by the prescriber and ultimately CCBHO.
- The CSBBH Team cannot act in an educational capacity, schoolwork or tests cannot be sent to be done with CSBBH staff in the team room.



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- The CSBBH Team cannot act in a disciplinary role; students cannot serve detentions or suspensions in the team room. Team should not be informing parents regarding school disciplinary issues.
- The CSBBH Team can participate in meetings with parents and student as necessary to address concerns. Team can work with student and parent on the behaviors that led to disciplinary issues.
- As our program is to be delivered in a flexible manner in the home, school and community. MTs and BHTs may
 be out of the building during the school day, conducting family sessions or engaging in other necessary
 responsibilities.
- The CSBBH team will do their best to ensure services are provided at the number of hours prescribed by the Written Order, these services are provided both during school hours as well as outside of school hours.
- MTs and BHTs conduct proactive individual therapeutic sessions with students on the team, and as a result
 will need access to students during class time. Teachers will be consulted to determine the best time to
 ensure the least disruption to academic learnings.
- BHTs can support students in the class, lunch and recess but cannot act as a one-on-one as they have to also provide services to the other students on the team.
- The number of staff may be decreased or increased based on number of appropriate referrals.

School District:

- District Superintendent endorses the implementation of the CSBBH Team Program
- District staff members commit to participate in an orientation of adoption of School wide Positive Behavior Supports (SWPBIS) and integration of school mental health.

School Building Principal Commitments:

- Meet 2 times a year to review agreement.
- School administration will provide a dedicated space for the team that can be secured, that includes a working space with electrical outlets, a phone line and internet access. The space needs to be private to allow for confidential therapeutic interventions with students and their families and large enough to facilitate groups.
- Changes in the CSBBH team room may need to be approved by the PA Office of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services.
- School administration will identify school staff (guidance counselors, administrators) who will participate in
 Core Meetings with the CSBBH team, which will need to occur at least twice monthly. These meetings will be
 used to discuss referrals and upcoming discharges, review student's progress in treatment, discuss any
 upcoming dates staff may be out of the building and any areas that may need improvement.
- If a child is identified as being a potential referral, a school representative will contact the family to see if they
 wish to be contacted by a team member. A referral form would then be filled out and given to the Team with the
 necessary contact information.
- Administrator will designate a primary contact at the school for the CSBBH Team and Community Care for ongoing communication.



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- Utilization of the CSBBH Team as a consultative resource during crisis, for both CSBBH enrolled students and for coordination with formal crisis services when needed.
- Support of Community Care's CSBBH evaluation Plan by encouraging teacher completion of the Strength and Difficulty Questionnaire (SDQ) on a quarterly basis and an end of year Satisfaction Survey provided by Community Care.
- Arranging for an orientation for the CSBBH Team staff that address: district/building policies and procedures, dress code, ID badges, sign-in requirements, parking, daily schedules, school calendar and other areas deemed important.
- Assuring a school representative, who knows the student, participates in Treatment Team Meetings at the minimum of every 6 months, or more frequently if needed.
- Ensuring that families can attend meetings within the school building including additional people identified as needed resources for treatment planning and delivery of service.
