

CHS National Junior Honor Society (NJHS)

We are proud to announce the implementation of the newly created National Junior Honor Society (NJHS) here at CHS. The goal of the program is to formally recognize our 7th and 8th graders for achieving a standard of excellence in academics, service, leadership and character. Eligible students will be formally recognized in a NJHS induction held in February and expected to continue to maintain the standards of excellence throughout their membership. Student grades will be reviewed by the NJHS faculty council at the conclusion of the first semester to determine eligibility and eligible students will begin the application process shortly thereafter. Below is more information regarding eligibility and other key points about the CHS NJHS.

Eligibility for Selection

- Students eligible for selection must be in the seventh or eighth grade.
- Students eligible for selection must have been enrolled for a period equivalent to one semester at Canton Jr.-Sr. High School.
- Students eligible for selection must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 94% at the conclusion of the first semester.
- Eligible students will receive an application packet to be reviewed by the NJHS faculty council for acceptance *Minimum cumulative grade point average does not automatically qualify a student for acceptance.

Acceptance

- Students will be accepted into the NJHS based on scholarship, service, leadership and character
- Once accepted, students will be formally recognized at the NJHS Induction to be held in February

Maintaining Membership

- NJHS students will be placed on probation and may be dismissed if failing to maintain the academic and behavioral standards set forth in the NJHS by-laws

Misc

- 8th graders not meeting the eligibility requirements in 7th grade can reapply and cumulative average will be based on only the first semester of 8th grade
- NJHS is independent of NHS and members are not automatically eligible for NHS
